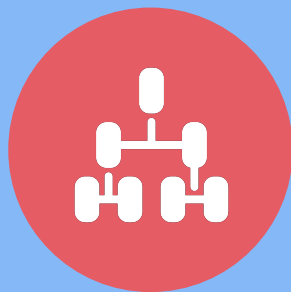
MEETING OBJECTIVES

VOTING ON AMENDMENT

Vice President (Head Safety Officer)

1. Role not necessary when there are Co-Presidents
2. The Vice President role is only for members who have held other roles within the club at least for two semesters. The Vice President in this role be at least a red belt for teaching
3. If the President is unable to fulfill his or her duties, the Vice President take over the presidential duties.
4. Lead risk management and other safety officers.
 - i. Must be registered as a safety officer on DSE Rec.
 1. The priority of Sports Club-sponsored safety officers goes to this role.
 - ii. First in line to accompany an injured member to hospital during tournaments or practice
5. Uphold all other responsibilities outlined in the Officer Handbook

10. If there are Co-Presidents:

- i. All presidential responsibilities will have an equal, 50/50 split of responsibilities between the two Co-Presidents
- ii. With no Vice President, one Co-President must be designated to manage the coaches and instructors, and the other must be designated to manage the safety officers.
- iii. If Co-Presidents cannot agree on a decision, the other Major Officers (Secretary, Treasurer) must vote to decide at the next officer meeting

P.L.U.S Coordinator

1. Plans PLUS events & tracks member participation
 - i. at least 1 LEAD event per semester
 - ii. at least 2 UNITE events per semester
 - iii. at least 3 SERVICE events per semester
2. Record supplementary events on DSE Rec.

MOUNTAIN CAMP

LEADERSHIP

You may have to take charge at times.

MODELING

Others may take after you in their behavior and actions.

AUTHORITY

Do not be afraid to call others out for misbehaving.

HEALTH

Please stay in good health to perform your duties.
